The aim of making the process of Project appraisal convenient, efficient, user-friendly and transparent, the Guidelines for Submission, Appraisal and Acceptance of Irrigation and Multipurpose Projects, 2017 issued by CWC envisages that the Pre-Feasibility Report (PFR), Detailed Project Report (DPR), Revised Cost Estimate (RCE) and Investment Clearance (IC) proposals of the State Governments and other departments shall be submitted by the Project Authority to CWC only through web-enabled e-PAMS (Project Appraisal Management System). The e-PAMS was launched during February 2019 which is now fully operational. With the objective to familiarize all stakeholders / users for submitting Projects through on-line using the e-PAMS portal, regular trainings and workshop on e-PAMS are being organized to build the capacity of all Stakeholders. Accordingly, Second Training-cum-Workshop on ePAMS (Project Appraisal Management System) through Distance Learning Tools is being organized by National Water Academy, Pune in association with PAO, CWC, New Delhi during 28-30 September 2020. The detailed session plan of the program is enclosed for information.

The DL program is intended to benefit officers from the State Water Resources Department / Irrigation Department of all States / Union Territories. It is requested that officers of AE/AD level to SE/ Director level from your organization involved in processing of clearance Irrigation and Flood Control Projects may be nominated for the above program.
